- **Sacramental** - almost always celebrating the Eucharist, also known as Holy Communion, the Lord's Supper, or the Mass;
- **Reverent** - treating our worship as the vital act of experiencing God's love for us;
- **Biblical** - reading extensive selections from Scripture each Sunday;
- **Thoughtful** - unpacking those Scriptures with an engaging sermon that welcomes and evokes deep questions and applies them to real life;
- **Joy-Filled** - finding deep fulfillment in communion with Christ and one another.
