Dear St. Paul's Parish:

We are finishing up our Sundays in Epiphany during the first part of the month and will begin the Lenten season on February 18 with our Ash Wednesday service. This begins the time of preparation for our celebration of Easter. The principal feast of the Church and the high point of the Christian year. The Lenten season is 40 days (excluding Sabbath). This follows several biblical periods from Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness, Moses' 40 days on the Mountain of Sinai, and Elijah's 40 days of wondering.

In the early days of the Church, Lent was dedicated to the preparation for Baptism and the preparation of penitents for reconciliation. Initially only those doing public penance would receive ashes on their foreheads. Then friends and relatives wanted to join in and show their affection for sinners and humility for their own sins. So, they asked to be marked with ashes. This eventually extended to the entire congregation in services like ours.

On Ash Wednesday, February 18, 2026, we will gather as a community to make our confessions. We come on Ash Wednesday to ask the Lord to create in us clean hearts and renew a right spirit within us.

And what a blessing we will be given as we are invited into a Holy Lent...invited into intimacy with God...invited to allow ourselves to be drawn to the very heart of God...where sin and death are not something to be feared. All Christians are invited to the observance of a Holy Lent, by self-examination and repentance; by prayer, fasting, and self-denial; and by reading and meditating on God's holy Word.

I invite you to draw closer with God and one another to prepare ourselves to be renewed into the mystery of Jesus' resurrection and our redemption.

We will also again celebrate our Annual Shrove Tuesday PANCAKE DINNER from 5:00pm to 6:30pm on February 17, 2026. This is for our members and friends to come and join us.

We will on Wednesday February 18 at 6:30pm have the Ash Wednesday EUCHARISTIC SERVICE with the imposition of Ashes.

Beginning on Friday February 27 and every Friday during Lent, we will have STATIONS OF THE CROSS at 12:15pm in the nave of the Church.

Beginning on Wednesday February 23, and every Wednesday during Lent we will continue to have Evening Prayer at 5:30pm in the Chapel. On February 23 we will have a soup supper after Evening Prayer at 6:30 pm. This will kick off our Lenten fellowship. We will additionally have a soup supper after the March 18 Evening Prayer service.

NOTE: We will celebrate a MORNING PRAYER SERVICE AND HAVE A LENTEN STUDY AT 12:10 PM ON MONDAY FEBRUARY 23, AND EVERY MONDAY DURING LENT. (WE REALIZE THE TIME LIMITATIONS FOR THOSE THAT ARE WORKING.) COME JOIN US!

HAVE A HOLY AND BLESSED LENT.


