Dear St. Paul's Parish:

Well Spring has sprung.....well at least it seems like it has. And Summer here we come. We have continued to have unusual weather. Very chilly or very hot with not much in the middle. I have a feeling we are going to have a lot of HOT from now on through the end of summer. We are grateful for the recent rain. Thank you Lord!

We have just finished the Easter Season with the celebration of the Ascension of Christ our Lord and the Day of Pentecost which signifies the coming of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church.

The Church now moves into the season of Ordinary Time (the Time after Pentecost) which is signified by green on the altar and green vestments which symbolize hope, life and continuous growth. On Sunday into this Ordinary season (first Sunday after Pentecost) we had Trinity Sunday. It was a Celebration of the one and equal glory of Father, Son and Holy Spirit, celebrated with white on the altar and white vestments.

The Ordinary season is the longest season of the Church year, beginning the Monday after Pentecost and lasting all the way through summer and autumn until the start of advent. Sundays are counted using ordinal numbers (for instance The Fourth Sunday after Pentecost). Ordinal is actually where the word "ordinary" originates.

The focus is on spiritual formation—a season to build faithful, everyday habits without the distraction of special events and holidays. It is a time to focus on Jesus' day-to-day teachings and how to be faithful in our daily lives.

Remember we are having Holy Eucharist on Wednesday evening at 5:30pm as well. Come and get a mid-week boost from the Eucharist. It is a good time to rest, reflect and re-charge.
